NOTICE TO BIDDERS: Bids will be received by the Angel of the Winds Casino Resort, wholly owned by the Stillaguamish Tribe of Indians, for the construction of the Water and Wastewater Facility Improvements. The facilities are located on the Stillaguamish Tribal Reservation. The wastewater facility improvements will include a new mechanical screen, new equalization basin with pumps & force main, and replacement of the existing OV400 membranes with new OV480 membranes. The water facility improvements will include completion work for new well #5, new water treatment building with new filter system for iron/manganese removal, carbon dioxide stripping system for pH adjustment, new simplex water transfer pump system, new triplex water booster pump system, standpipe inlet/outlet piping adjustments for chlorine contact time requirements, electrical controls, instrumentation, SCADA programming, yard piping, fencing, and misc. work items. The new OV480 membrane assemblies have been pre-purchased by the Owner and will be provided to the Contractor.
