

INVITATION TO BID

LUMMI BAY HATCHERY WATER SUPPLY

Sealed bids will be received by the undersigned at the Lummi Indian Business Council, Public Works conference room, 2nd floor, 2665 Kwina Road; Bellingham, WA 98226 up to 2:00 pm local time on May 25, 2021 and will then and there be opened and publicly read.

All bid proposals must be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, money order, or surety bond payable to Lummi Indian Business Council and in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specification, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Lummi Indian Business Council.

The bids will be evaluated by Lummi Public Works, Lummi Natural Resource Personnel, and the Project Engineer based on cost and Contractor qualifications. Owner reserves the right to waive any bid irregularities and to reject any or all bids for any reason, or no reason at all, if it deems that to do so is in the Owner's best interests.

The Lummi Bay Hatchery Water Supply Project is the construction of a pump house to replace an existing pump house that has sustained significant storm damage. The project involves installing an access road, constructing the pump house, providing and installing equipment, including, temporary erosion control, traffic control, and other work, all in accordance with the attached Contract Plans, these Contract Provisions, and the Standard Specifications.

The Lummi Nation Tribal Employment Rights Ordinance (TERO) applies to this project for contractor and subcontractors for more information please contact the TERO office at 360-312-2122.

The Contractor and Subcontractors are subject to compliance with the LIBC Alcohol and Drug Free Workplace Policy. All contractors and subcontractors working on public improvement contracts shall demonstrate that an employee drug testing program is in place.
